More than any other youth program available today, Cub Scouting supports parent and child relationships in ways that result in lasting memories of time well spent together. As a parent you get to guide your child thru several Scout program experiences:

- Work on projects together
- Go places together
- Talk together

One example is camping at Scout overnight and day camp opportunities which introduce your child to the camping experience and Scout themed activities and skills. Another is sharing fun experiences that you might not otherwise have done on your own.

Scouts Work and Play Together

How Does Cub Scouting Work?

Cub Scouting takes place at two levels. **Your child will be a part of a den, a small group of boys or girls in the same grade level who meet at least monthly.** Individually and as a den, your child works thru various achievements to earn each rank. Your den leader will show you how all this works. Den Rank Levels:

- Lion Den (Kindergarten)
- Tiger Cub Den (Grade 1)
- Wolf Cub Scout Den (Grade 2)
- Bear Cub Scout Den (Grade 3)
- Webelos I Scout Den (Grade 4)
- Webelos II Scout Den (Grade 5)

After Webelos II, Scouts, upon completing their requirements, will receive the Arrow of Light and may choose to join a local Scout troop.

All dens, from grades K through 5, make up a pack. Once a month, the dens are together at the pack meeting. Scouts are recognized for accomplishments, show some spirit and have some fun with an engaging activity or guest.

Cub Scouts is a completely volunteer run program so parent participation is necessary to make the pack run smoothly. Opportunities range from leadership to organizing an activity for your Scout's den and everything in between.
